SERVING SUGGESTIONS

Elevate the guest experience:

Serve Juicy Yuzu over clean, solid ice and top with chilled premium sparkling water at a 1:1 or 1:2 ratio.

On the rocks:

Pour it neat over a single large ice sphere in a lowball glass. As the ice slowly melts, it opens up the spirit to reveal a sophisticated interplay of deep citrus richness and characteristic structural bitterness.

Upgrade your beverage program:

Swap Juicy Yuzu into a classic Spritz with prosecco, or use it as a dynamic premium substitute for triple sec or citrus juices in a Margarita or Collins.
